Mazzell Sherman, 84, a longtime Manson resident and Orchard owner, passed away at home on Monday, April 5, 2021.

She was born on April 17, 1936 at Farmers Hill, Oklahoma, to the late Virgil and Sarah Ann (Giddings) Rogers. She married her hometown sweetheart Charles Sherman in 1954, shortly after graduating high school. Charles was home on a short leave from Uijeonghu, Korea, when she married him on February 15, 1954 in Valliant, Oklahoma. Once Charles was home for good, they set their sites for Manson Washington, where the apple industry was starting to flourish. Working for various apple growers here in the valley, they purchased their own orchard in 1972 and have been farming ever since.
