



## Michael D Johnson

December 6, 1958 - February 19, 2018

Michael D. Johnson, 58, a five year Wenatchee resident and a former longtime Duvall resident, passed away at his home in Wenatchee on February 19, 2018, following a sudden illness.

He was born on December 6, 1959 in Seattle to the late Alvin D. and Melba L. (Haugen) Johnson. He made many moves while growing up with his father's Coast Guard career. They had lived in the greater Spokane and Seattle areas as well as many other areas.

Michael graduated from Interlake High School at Bellevue, Washington, with the class of 1977. He went to work for Todd's Shipyards in the Harbor Island area of Seattle. He worked on the construction of new ships at Todd's Shipyard for over 15 years. He then worked at various industrial construction paint shops which included industrial commercial, high lift crane site painting and powder coating jobs. He retired in 2012 and moved to Wenatchee to be near to and help take care of his father. In September of 2014, he moved to the Cottages at Saddlerock, to live nextdoor to his brother.

His favorite car was his first car, a 1967 Mustang Fastback that he painted emerald green.

He is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Halen & Dyan Johnson, Westerville, Ohio; his brother, Ken Johnson, Wenatchee and his best friend since the third grade, Todd Hauser, Camas, WA. He was preceded in death by his parents.
