Nancy Faith Webber, 77, a longtime Wenatchee Valley Resident, passed away on Monday, October 25, 2021, at her East Wenatchee home following an extended illness.

Nancy was born on December 24, 1943, at Chelan, Washington to the late Rodney K and Pauline M (Morden) Martin. At an early age, her family moved to Wenatchee. She grew up in Wenatchee and attended Wenatchee Schools. She met and later married Rodney M Webber on November 6, 1959, at Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. They made their first home together in Wenatchee, before moving to East Wenatchee. While Rodney was stationed in Germany with the 34th Medical Evac Company, their first son was born. They spent much of Rodney's time in the service in Germany.

They returned to Wenatchee in October of 1963, where they remained until moving to their East Wenatchee residence in 1974.

Nancy became a Nurses Aid at Parkside Convalescent Center and soon became a cook and remained as a head cook for many years. She later

worked at local fruit sheds as a sorter and packer. She had worked at Dovex, BlueBird and Don Holeman fruit packers. Nancy loved her family, especially her grandchildren. She enjoyed going out with her sisters and camping with her family.

Nancy was a Charter Member of Valley View Seventh-day Adventist Church of East Wenatchee and had been a former member of the Wenatchee Seventh-day Adventist Church.
