Noreen Mary Brown, 67, a recent Wenatchee resident and former longtime Pacific Beach, Washington resident, passed away on Saturday morning, June 2, 2012 in Wenatchee, following an extended illness.

She was born on June 10, 1944 at Albany, New York. She was raised in the Northeastern part of the United States while making numerous moves with her father's railroad job. Following her graduation from high school, she continued her education by attending Nursing College in Indiana.
