



Orville Herbert Busch

December 13, 1928 - May 15, 2014

Orville H. Busch, 85, Wenatchee, a former longtime Wallace Idaho resident, passed away on Thursday, May 15, 2014 at Highgate Assisted Living Wenatchee, following an extended illness.

He was born on December 13, 1928 in North Dakota to the late Herbert and Rose (Hoerter) Busch. He was a young child when his family moved to Wallace, Idaho; it is here that he attended school. When Orville turned 17 he joined the US Marine Corps and served in Korea during the conflict. Upon his honorable discharge he lived in Soap Lake where he went to work for Great Northern Railroad as rail yard mechanic in Ephrata. He was later transferred to Wenatchee and then after the rail yard explosion, to Richland.

He is preceded in death by his parents; brother, Bernard "Bernie" Busch; sisters, June Novello and Ethel Morse.

He is survived by his sister Laurel Sissom, Albuquerque, NM and brothers, Robert "Bob" (Sonia) Busch, East Wenatchee, Merrill (Delphine) Busch, Milwaukie, OR and numerous nieces and nephews.
