Patrick Allen Riley, 57, a 34 year Wenatchee resident, passed away on Tuesday morning, July 17, 2012 at Central Washington Hospital, following an extended illness.

He was born on March 30, 1955 at Bellingham, Washington to the late Omer William and Eva Emery (Brown) Riley. He was raised and received his schooling in Bellingham. While in his late teens, he moved to Spokane, where he began working as a pruner for a Christmas tree farm and quickly specialized in tree pruning. He moved to Wenatchee in the mid 1970's and went to work in the area orchards. He met and was married to Mar Lee (Jensen) Aultman on December 15, 1978 in Wenatchee. They continued to make their home together in Wenatchee.

He became a warehouseman and a fork lift operator and had worked for Skookum, Dole, H&H and Chief Wenatchee. Due to ill health, he was forced to retire early.

Patrick was a former member of the Eastmont Baptist Church in East Wenatchee. He enjoyed the outdoors, camping and especially going fishing. He was a caring man that always went out of his way to help other people with their yardwork, snow removal and other obvious needs.

He is survived by his wife, Mary L. Riley, Wenatchee; one son, Ron Riley, Wenatchee; step-son and his wife, Ray & Deniese Aultman, Wenatchee; one step daughter, Mary M. Aultman, Wenatchee and one granddaughter, Jade Aultman, Wenatchee. He was preceded in death by his parents and one

brother, Bill Riley.
