Pat was born February 23, 1929 at the home of his grandmother in Pocatello, Idaho and raised at Anderson Ranch Dam near Mountain Home, Idaho.

Growing up in the Depression, he began working at anything possible including driving a logging truck down the mountains when he was 13 years old. He graduated from Mountain Home High School in 1948 and served in the U.S. Army 1950-52 in Germany during the Occupation.

He always loved the Big Band Music of the 1930's and 40's and knew the names of the bands and singers. He worked construction on many of the big dams.

He married Bertha L. "Bert" Fricke in 1954 at Jackson, Wyoming. They were together 61 years.

He is survived by Bert, their two children, Patrick, Los Angeles, CA and Kelly and husband Dale Peterson, Manson, WA; three grandchildren, Faye, Ryan and Roselyn Peterson and his brother Glenn Sinclair, Endicott, WA.
