Paula Ray Sarvis, 72, a 39 year Wenatchee area resident, passed away suddenly on Monday, March 24, 2014 in Wenatchee.

She was born on April 29, 1941 and was raised by Walter and Lois Goman in Coulee City, Washington and graduated from the Coulee City High School. She met and was later married to Bobby Gene Sarvis. While Gene served in the US Navy they were transferred and together they made their home in Loris, South Carolina. On December 7, 1974, Bobby was tragically killed in an automobile accident. In 1975 Paula moved her family to East Wenatchee and throughout time they lived in Rock Island and Wenatchee. She gained employment in the area fruit warehouses as a sorter. Years later Paula took classes and earned her Certified Nurse's Assistant Certification; until retiring she worked at Colonial Vista Retirement Home.

She is preceded in death by her parents; husband Bobby; two sons, Dwayne & Randy Sarvis; grandson, Tracy Sarvis and two infant granddaughters.
