



## Peggy Ann Spaeth

June 7, 1940 - November 3, 2011

Peggy Spaeth, 71, a longtime Rock Island resident and a Wenatchee area resident for over 60 years, passed away at her home on Thursday morning, November 3, 2011, following an extended illness.

She was born on June 7, 1940 at Seattle, Washington to Stiemann and Maureen (Ingham) Allen. She was raised and started elementary school in Skykomish prior to the family moving to East Wenatchee.
