Peter Joseph Milos Wenatchee, WA Pete was born in Ronald, WA to Peter and Angelina (Kuchin) Milosevich on December 29, 1922, and died in Wenatchee, April 18, 2010. He graduated from Easton High School, lettering in basketball. Dad entered the Navy in 1944, after marrying our mother, Dorothy Matkovich, in Ellensburg, WA in 1943. Dad worked at the #3 mine in Ronald, before moving to Wenatchee in 1952, where he worked as a Warehouseman for Pacific Fruit. After retirement, he enjoyed golf, driving cars for the Toyota dealership and being with family. Pete was a lifetime member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles. He enjoyed bowling and was a member of two league teams in the 1960's and 1970's. His best game was a 279, consisting of nine strikes and a spare. In the early 1970's, he was a member of the WHS 'chain gang' trio, who ran line markers for all home Panther football games. Dad liked maple nut ice cream and loved to fashion the perfect Costco hotdog; mustard and relish with

just a bit of sauerkraut. A recent favorite was the large popcorn with a cold beer while cheering on the Wenatchee Wild.

Pete is survived by his wife, Dorothy; son, Gene (Gay); and daughter, Patti, all of Wenatchee; five grandchildren; and 11 great-grandchildren. Also, his two adored feline companions, Whiskers and Pebbles. He was preceded in death by his parents; three sisters; and a brother.
