Randee Cate, 52, of East Wenatchee, Washington, passed away on August 2, 2025, in East Wenatchee.

Randee was born on September 29, 1972. In later years, September 29th would become National Coffee Day, and those who knew Randee might wonder if he had a say in that.

Born in Wenatchee, Washington, Randee grew up in the community he would call home for much of his life. He graduated from Eastmont High School in East Wenatchee in 1990 and later pursued higher education at Central Washington University in Ellensburg, earning his degree in 2010.

Randee was known by those around him as a creative and talented artist. His passion for creating art was matched by his love of baseball – playing, coaching, and watching (Go Red Sox!) – and of working with his hands—whether it was shooting or spending time under the hood of his truck. He found joy in simple pleasures like sharing coffee with friends and immersing himself in the imaginative worlds of Star Wars, Marvel Comics, The Lord of the Rings, and The Chronicles of Narnia.

His faith was an important part of his life. After previously attending Newsong Community Church, Randee became a member of Wenatchee Church of the

Nazarene, where he found spiritual connection and community. He provided designs for many of the church ministries, maintained the church website, prepared Sunday morning videos for viewing, acted as a representative at District Assembly, and served as a board member.

Randee is survived by his wife, Misi Cate; daughters: Abby Cate and Lily Cate; son, Simon Cate; stepson Drew Pomeroy; one grandson; brothers: Jack Nystrom and Chris (Kathy) Nystrom; sisters: Janet Billingsley and Lisa (Warren) Harvey; as well as several nieces and nephews and numerous great-nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Marcella Cate; father, Terry Cate; brother, Michael Nystrom; and nephew, Kye Davis.

Randee's intelligence, humor, and artistic spirit left a lasting impression on those who knew him. May his memory bring comfort to all who mourn his passing.
