Remel Sims, 75, a longtime Wenatchee resident, passed away January 26, 2015, surrounded by loved ones, following a courageous battle with cancer. Remel was born on December 2, 1939, to Homer and Avis (Tate) Sims at Melbourne, AR. At the age of six, he moved with his family to Cashmere, WA, where he attended school and graduated in 1958. Remel was avidly known in the trucking industry of the Wenatchee Valley. He began driving for Richfield Petroleum and worked there until 1969, when he then started his own, "Remel Sims Trucking Company", which is still in operation today. Remel had a strong passion for his trucking company, as well as spending any free time on his boat exploring the Puget Sound and Canada. Remel married Darla Wright of Cashmere in 1968, and was later married to Linda Kramer of Wenatchee.

Remel is survived by a daughter, Dawn Sims of Wenatchee; his sisters, Janet Henry of Chelan, and Debi Harman of Wenatchee; sister-in-law, Mary Sims of Peshastin; his nieces, Cari McLaren of Chelan, and Tammy Sims of Peshastin; his nephews, Bret Henry of Chelan, and Ryan Harman of Richland; many great-nieces and nephews; a close cousin, Carl Tate; and a friend, Vicky. He was preceded in death by his parents, Homer and Avis Sims; and his brother, Donnie Sims.
