



## Robert "Bob" Olin

Robert "Bob" Olin, 84, died Monday, March 18th at Central Washington Hospital.

Bob was born in Monroe Washington on November 19, 1939 to Perry and Margaret (Crow) Olin. His family resided in Coulee City, Washington. After he retired from the state, he worked for a few trucking companies until he settled and finished his working life as a bus driver for Waterville School District. Bob started with the district as a full-time bus driver and then went on to drive their Athletic bus. He loved this job, and he loved the kids he drove the bus for throughout the years. He enjoyed going to the games and watching the kids grow.

Bob had a love for farming and fixing things. He could fix just about anything that you gave him. The things he loved most in his life were his children, grandchildren, and his wife of 50 years. Everything that he did here on earth was for them.

Bob is survived by his wife, three sons, two daughters, and many grandchildren. Bob is preceded in death by his mother, father, two brothers, and a grandson.
