Ronald Eugene "Ron" Foutch, 72, of Wenatchee and a former longtime Carlton resident, passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, June 15, 2017.

Ron was born to Betty Joy Barta on October 18, 1944 at Richmond, California. He spent most of youth in Kalispell and Big Fork, Montana. He graduated from the Flathead County High School in Kalispell, with the class of 1962. He continued his education attending college at Sheridan, Wyoming and while there he met and was later married to Karen Cecilia Floretta in 1963.
