Scott Douglas Whitman, 69 of Leavenworth, WA, passed away on June 20, 2023. He was born on September 21, 1953, in Wenatchee, WA, the son of Beulah M. Whitman and the late Norman L. Whitman. Growing up, Scott was a member of Boy Scout Troop 17 in Monitor, in which his dad was Scoutmaster. He also enjoyed baseball, playing Little League, Babe Ruth, and the American Legion, and would go on to play on various softball teams as an adult. Scott graduated from Wenatchee High School in 1972. He loved building things, riding snowmobiles, and working on cars. He started a boat-building business, American Jet Boat, with Anthony Nelson, where the two of them built a custom aluminum jet boat. Motorcycles were a huge passion and he would make many trips around the US on one of his many bikes.

Scott was a hard worker from an early age. He would do odd jobs for neighbors and took a job at Zittings Grocery in Wenatchee at the age of 15 to save up for his first car. After high school, he would go on to work for Alcoa Wenatchee Works on the potlines. Scott would then go on to work for the Chelan County PUD and retired after 32 years of service as a Utilityman, Apprentice Mechanic, Diver Mechanic, Journeyman Mechanic, and Foreman Mechanic.

Scott is survived by the love of his life, Barbara Skylstad. Mother Beulah Whitman, sisters Jeri (Craig) Beier, Carol Trainer, and Staci Richardson and

brother David Whitman; nieces and nephews Adam Trainer, Heather Johnson, Nicole Greene, Drew Whitman, and Katelyn Richardson; Andrea (Chris) Brixey, Stephen (Carly) Skylstad and sons Connor, Brady, and Anderson; Todd (Tiffany) Skylstad and sons Cooper and Boden; lifelong friends Dale Harris and Roy Vespier.
