



Stephen Allen Sprauer

August 11, 1955 - February 8, 2013

Steve Sprauer, 57, a longtime Wenatchee area resident, passed away at his home in East Wenatchee on Friday, February 8, 2013, following an extended illness.

He was born on August 11, 1955 in Wenatchee to the late Leo and Mary Ann (Eskew) Sprauer. Steve was raised on his family farm near Withrow and attended Withrow Elementary School. He attended Waterville High School and graduated with the class of 1973. He continued his education at Wenatchee Valley College and after receiving his Associates Degree he furthered his education with technical school welding courses in the Tri Cities. He returned to work on the family farm in Withrow and remained there until moving to Wenatchee during the late 1980's. He went to work in the Wenatchee area and ended his career as a truck driver for the Chelan County Public Works Department.

Steve loved his children, his computer, reading, cars and building model cars and was fond of sleeping.
