Terry Keith Luebeck, 78, passed away on December 30, 2021. He was born July 6, 1943, in Sedro Wooley, WA to Harold Maxwell and Marjorie Monnett and later adopted by John Luebeck.

Terry graduated from Sumner High School, in 1961. After Graduation he enlisted in the US Navy until his honorable discharge August 4, 1964. He actively served upon the USS Bon Homme Richard (CVA-31), an aircraft carrier, for over 2 years as an airport serviceman. His most favorite port to dock was Sasebo, Japan prior to the Vietnam War. His ship also traveled the South China Sea as well as off the coast of India.

Terry Married Linda (Spears) Atchison on August 23, 1980, in Leavenworth WA. Where they joined their children together, Christine, Stephanie, Jennifer and Jody. Terry and Linda moved to Puyallup WA, where he worked at Gordon Trucking as a truck driver and Dispatcher. They moved back to Cashmere in 1988, where they owned and operated Cashmere Mini Mart and Deli. He also helped out with the Spears Family pear orchard.

Terry and Linda moved to Orting WA in 1995 where he worked at Interstate Trucking. Upon his retirement, he and Linda moved back to Cashmere in 2010.

Terry enjoyed fishing, hunting, camping, race cars, watching the Seahawks, Mariners, and traveling. Some of the places they enjoyed were Mazama and Westport, WA, Indio, Bakersfield, Chula Vista, California, Yuma and Tucson, AZ, Puerto Penasco and Puerto Vallarta, Mexico, Las Vegas, NV, crabbing in Charleston, OR, and yearly boat rentals with family and friends at Lake Roosevelt. Some of the friends and family they enjoyed traveling/camping with were the Kennedy's, Ingraham's, Lanuza's, Spears, Duncan's, Brunner's, Wildfang, and Limbeck's. This continued up until Linda's passing in 2015. Terry continued to go on fishing trips to Alaska and traveled to New Orleans and Australia over the last few years.
