



## Valerie Jean Fugelseth

February 23, 1963 - November 19, 2010

Valerie Jean Fugelseth, 47, a Wenatchee area resident for 25 years, passed away on Friday November 19, 2010 in Wenatchee.

She was born on February 23, 1963 in Havre, Montana to Einar Roy and Patricia Ann (Carlson) Fugelseth. She was raised, attended elementary, Jr. high and high school at Havre, Montana. She graduated from high school in 1981 and continued her education at Northern Montana College in Havre. In 1984, she moved to Wenatchee, where she lived with her aunt, Ardelle Miller. During the late 1980's, she returned to college and completed the X-Ray Technician Program at Wenatchee Valley College. She became a Certified Radiologic Technician and went to work at Coulee Community Hospital in Grand Coulee, Washington. She met and was married to John Edmonson on October 1, 1994 in Grand Coulee, where they made their home. They later made a brief move to Bridgeport. They were later divorced. She moved to Cashmere in the early 1990's. She remained in Cashmere until moving to East Wenatchee in 2007 and to Wenatchee in 2008.

Valerie enjoyed riding horses with her father when she was younger, as well as going camping and the outdoors.

She is survived by her father and step-mother, Einar and Jann Fugelseth, Elgin, OR; her daughter, Caleaha Fugelseth, Montana City, MT; three sisters and two brothers-in-law, Denise and Mike Haugen, Spokane, Cynthia and Gary Flathers, Montana City, MT and Michele Fugelseth, Medical Lake, WA and one brother, Steven Fugelseth, Spokane. She was preceded in death by

her daughter, Brittney Fugelseth in August of 2010 and by her mother, Patricia Fugelseth in 1995.
