Verneen A. White, 102, a 73 year Wenatchee area resident, passed away on Friday, November 27, 2015 in East Wenatchee following an extended illness. She was born on October 12, 1913 at Violet Hill, Arkansas, daughter of George and Nettie (Jones) Hellums. She was raised in Violet Hill and following the death of her mother when she was six years old, she became the matriarch of the household. She was married to Tommie White on September 24, 1933 at Pleasant Ridge, Arkansas. They moved their family to Monitor in 1942 and settled in Wenatchee in 1943. Verneen worked for the Valley Evaporating Company for many years.
