William R. "Bill" Scott, 83, a longtime Rock Island resident and Central Washington area resident for over 50 years, passed away on Sunday, June 12, at Colonial Vista Care Center.

He was born on February 25, 1928 at Froid, Montana, son of the late Walter R. Hattie B. (Krogadahl) Scott. He was raised in Montana and after completion of his schooling, he began working in the cattle industry. He entered the U.S. Army in 1944 and served during W.W.II and reenlisted in January 1951 and served during the Korean Conflict. He received his honorable discharge in 1954. On September 5, 1956, he was married to Martha Scott in Chelan. They made their home together in the Central Washington area where he worked as an orchardist. They moved to make their home in Rock Island in the mid 1980's where he worked in the area orchards. They moved into the Marine R.V. Park in Rock Island in 1995 and he worked as an assistant grounds keeper. On July 29, 1999, he was preceded in death by his wife, Martha. He has since continued to make his home in Rock Island.

Bill especially enjoyed fishing and hunting.

He is survived by a host of many friends and acquaintances.
