Zane William Sand, 61, a 32 year resident and longtime Wenatchee Valley painting contractor, passed away on Wednesday, April 2, 2014. He was born on December 15, 1952 in Milwaukee, WI to the late Kenneth Edward and Genevieve Carolyn (Williams) Sand. At the age of two he moved with his family to Granada Hills, CA. In 1971, he graduated from James Monroe High School in nearby Sepulveda, CA. Following high school he married his high school sweetheart, Laurie Beaver on May 10, 1975 in Granada Hills, CA. Following a visit to the Wenatchee Valley, they fell in love with the area and in 1982 they made it their home. Zane began painting in Wenatchee in 1982 and started his own business, Valley Painting Service, in 1989, which he operated with the assistance of his son Zane. He was a member of the Wenatchee Eagles Lodge, Aerie #204. An outdoorsman, Zane enjoyed riding his Harley Davidson, boating, fishing, snow skiing and the warm waters of Hawaii and Mexico. A master barbecuer, he loved his ice-cold beer, a good steak and the company of his family, especially his granddaughter, Eliana. Zane leaves behind his wife of 38 years, Laurie Sand, his son, Zane A. Sand, his daughter, Julie Parker, his son-in-law, Brandon Parker, his granddaughter, Eliana Parker, all of Wenatchee; two sisters, Jetta (Paul) Rodal, Granada Hills, CA, and Janell Sand, Spokane, WA. He was preceded in death by his parents.
